- > 20 organisations included.
 - Public authorities
 - Research funders
 - QA agencies, including ENQA
- Draft out for internal consultation.

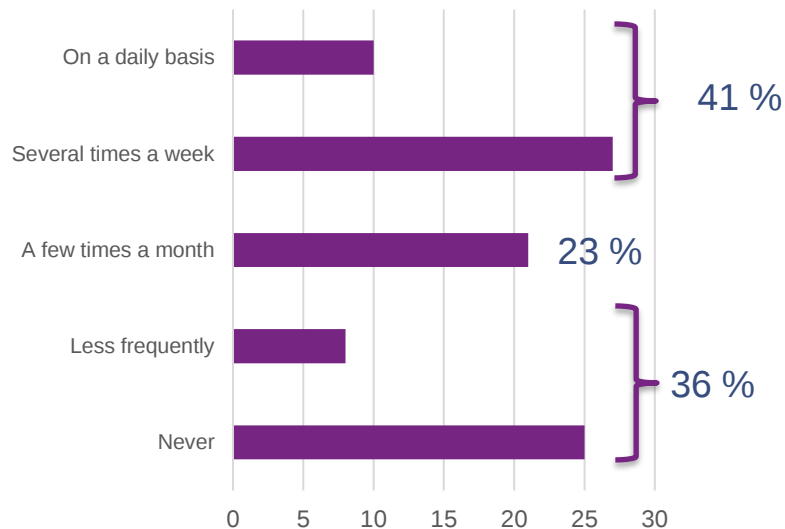
Current situation

The Use of Generative AI Tools (snapshot at UKÄ)

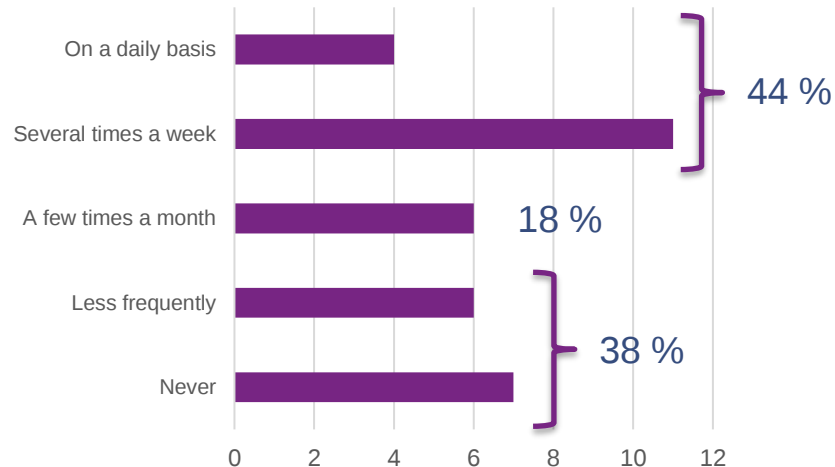
- Survey

- Response rate: 92 percent

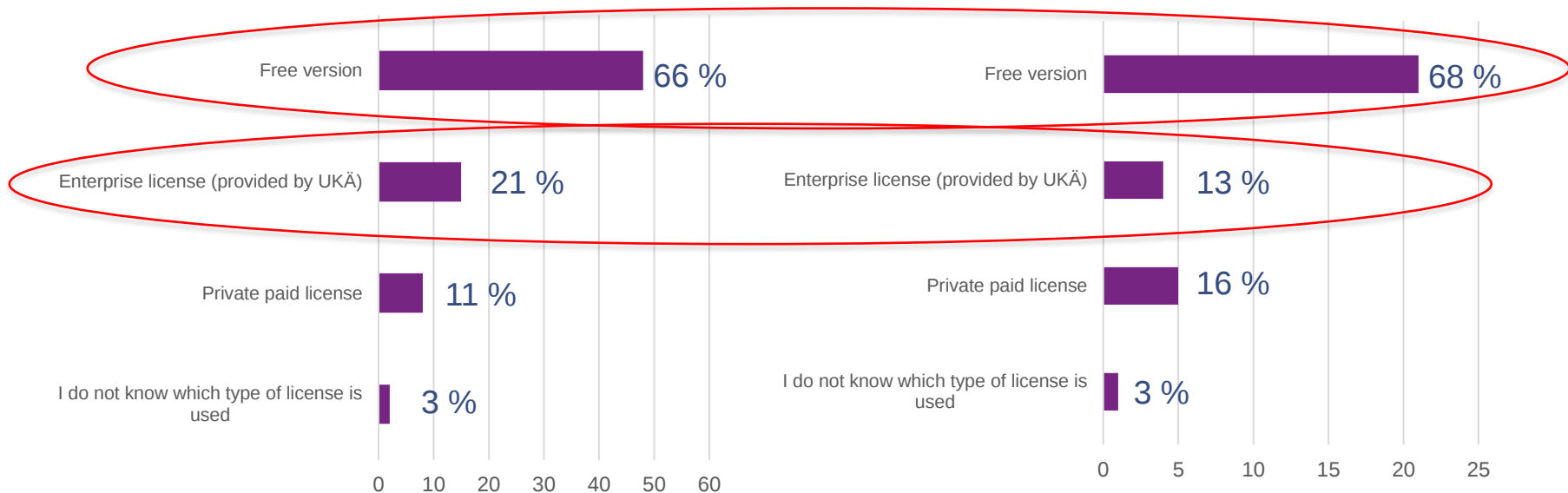
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What type of account/license do you use for these AI tools? (Number of responses among AI users)

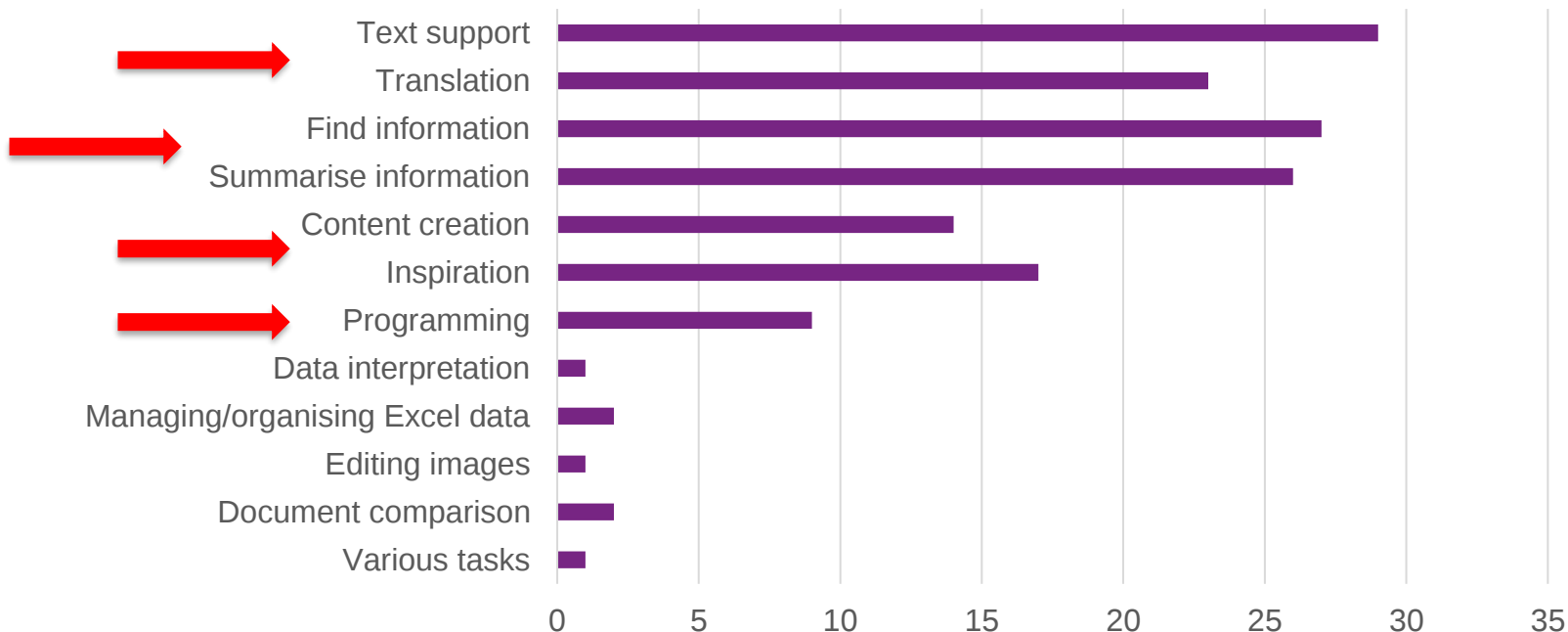
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What do you use the tools for? (Number of responses)
