## Orienting questions:

We would like you to think about these questions in advance; you don't need to bring 'the answers' with you! The questions will underpin our discussions during the seminar.

- 1. What are the roles and responsibilities of school partners in supporting the students' work on the research underlying the Master's thesis?
- 2. How can universities support school partners in this work and re-define their own roles and responsibilities in the five-year Master's programme?

- 12.45-13.30 Session 2: Video (and face-to-face) presentations of example MA theses During this session, we will watch some short videos and listen to one presentation from colleagues at the University of Tromsø that introduce examples of practice-oriented research studies of teaching and learning. The videos/presentations are accompanied by handouts that provide more detail about each study.
- 13.30-14.30 Session 3: A closer look at the video examples

  During this session, we will examine the presented studies in terms of their research topics, research questions, data sources and analytical tools, as well as the usefulness of their findings.
